**Start:** Alpspitzbahn top terminal

The Alpspitzbahn top terminal is the starting point for this via ferrata. The trail leads in a southerly direction initially to just below the Hollentorkopf. After a walk of around 15 minutes, follow signs for „Ferrata“, which lead to the entry point of the Alpspitz Ferrata. This route with wire ropes and steel pins takes you to the summit of the majestic Alpspitz. After around one and a half hours of climbing, savour the fabulous view of Garmisch-Partenkirchen in the valley, the imposing Zugspitze on the left and the surrounding mountain peaks. You can either return the way you came from along the Alpspitz Ferrata, or head down the mountain's eastern flank over scree and gravel to the Oberkar. From there, the tour leads over the Nordwandsteig (North Face Climb) and back to the top terminal of the Alpspitzbahn, which transports you comfortably back to the valley.

## Attention

Via ferrate: Appropriate skills and equipment are necessary. Sure footedness and a good head for heights required.
